Goal(s):

- Families will reflect on and share about their experiences and sacramentals from their own First Holy Communion.
- Families will share a photo of themselves around their home altar or prayer space, practicing • their favorite Advent or Christmas tradition.
- Families will explain why it is their favorite tradition, as well as how they will celebrate the Birth of Christ on Christmas Day and during the whole Christmas Season.

ICE BREAKER

Penguins

- 1. Have enough sheets of paper for everyone in your group (these are the blocks of ice) and spread them around on the floor of your room.
- 2. Have everyone get on a block of ice, one per block.
- 3. When you start music or blow a whistle, "penguins" jump off their blocks and waddle around like penguins (arms stuck to sides) till the music stops and they must get back on a block of ice.
- 4. While music is playing, remove a block of ice.

REVIEW MAIN CONCEPT

FAMILY CONVERSATION

What do you remember most about your First Holy Communion and about how you felt when receiving Jesus for the first time? Why did you feel that way?

- 1. Model, remind, and help families to feel comfortable, by first answering the above question.
- 2. Briefly show examples of your First Holy Communion sacramentals and explain why they are special to you.
- 3. Invite the family members to show the sacramentals and photos from their own Sacrament of First Holy Communion and explain why they are special to them.

FAMILY CONVERSATION

Each family shares a photo of themselves around their home altar or prayer space practicing their favorite Advent or Christmas tradition. Then families explain why it is their favorite tradition, as well as how they will celebrate the Birth of Christ on Christmas Day and during the whole Christmas Season.

Celebration Ideas:

- Have a Christmas party/celebration with treats, Christmas carols, and games for the second half of your December gathering.
- Ask families to bring in food or small gift items for the homeless, elderly or others in need.
